___ / ___ **Pre-anesthetic Bloodwork** Recommended for all patients in order to detect conditions that might complicate or prohibit the anesthesia and procedure (**Cost:** \$136.50).

___ / ___ **Pain medication** Analgesic and anti-inflammatory drugs given before and after surgery may decrease post-operative pain and inflammation and allow your pet to have a more comfortable recovery. (**Cost:** depends on pet size and surgical procedure). **Note:** In some cases, the doctors may determine that pain medications are not optional and in the best interest of the patient

___ / ___ **IV Catheter and Fluid therapy** The IV catheter provides quick access to the veins in the case of an emergency. The fluids help keep the blood pressure at a normal level and help to protect the kidneys and liver during surgery. They also can help your pet wake up from anesthesia more quickly. **Required for pets over 8 years old.** (**Cost:** \$75.25)

___ / ___ **Microchip Placement** Our clinic recommends the implantation of a microchip I.D. underneath the skin in all of our patients to aid in their rescue if lost. Microchips are easily placed using a needle mechanism, especially while the pet is under anesthesia. (**Cost:** \$45.30)

___ / ___ **Nail Dremmel** We are able to trim the nails shorter and smoother. (**Cost:** \$11.50)
